#### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

#### **Unit: Free To Be Me**

## **Understandings:**

### **ENGLISH**

## Reading and Viewing

#### Your child will be:

- Engaging with a range of different types of texts for meaning.
- Considering storylines, ideas and relationships between characters to build literal and inferred meanings.
- Describing the effects of text structures and language features.

## **Writing**

#### Your child will be:

- Using grammar, punctuation and the use of correct tense to enhance their writing skills.
- Using text structures to sequence and connect ideas and to develop paragraphs.
- Editing their texts to improve content and structure
- Writing words using clearly formed joined letters with developing fluency.

### **Speaking and Listening**

### Your child will be:

- Using and developing their speaking and listening behaviours, including acknowledging and extending others' contributions, and presenting ideas and opinions clearly and coherently.
- Showing an understanding of how language is used to develop relationships in formal and informal situations.

#### MATHEMATICS

## **Unit: Addition and Subtraction**

- Applying Place Value knowledge to partition, rearrange and regroup numbers to at least tens of thousands to assist calculations and solve problems.
- Using equivalent number sentences involving addition and subtraction to find unknown quantities.

## **Unit: Time (Measurement)**

 Converting between units of time, using am and pm notation and solving simple time problems.

#### **Unit: Fractions**

- Investigating equivalent fractions used in different contexts.
- Counting by quarters, halves and thirds, including mixed numerals, and locating and representing these fractions on a number line.

### **Unit: Multiplication and Division**

- Investigating number sequences involving multiples of 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9.
- Recalling multiplication facts up to 10 × 10 and related division facts and developing efficient mental and written strategies to solve multiplication and division problems.

Unit: First Contacts Learning Area: History

## **Big Question/s:**

 How did first contacts between European settlers and the indigenous population impact on Australia as we know it today?

## **Understandings:**

- World navigators in the late eighteenth century had a significant impact on society as we know it today.
- There were significant events leading up to the First Fleet, and the colonisation of Australia.
- First contact and interactions between Europeans and indigenous population greatly impacted on the lives of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
- Australia's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples are diverse and are uniquely connected to Country and Place (land, sea, waterways and skies).

# Your child will be:

- Practicing and refining a range of fundamental movement skills that include striking, catching and throwing in a variety of game situations.
