RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Unit: Teach Us to Pray

- Understandings:Jesus Christ's prayer to God, 'The Lord's Prayer', shows Christians how to pray.
 - Christians practise various forms of prayer; thanksgiving, petition, praise and sorrow.
 - Formal and informal Prayer has various structures and forms in the Christian tradition; meditative, contemplative, and spontaneous.

Unit: Lent to Easter: We are Transformed

Understandings:

- During Lent, we consider choices that bring about healing and reconciliation.
- Christians believe that after death they will rise to new life with Christ.
- The stories, rituals and symbols of the Easter liturgy are signs of God's hope and transformation.

ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing

Your child will be:

- Selecting and reading different types of texts to read accurately and fluently for meaning, re-reading and self-correcting when needed.
- Understanding how the choice of verbs, elaborated tenses and a range of adverb groups can expand and sharpen ideas.
- Understanding how to use commas to separate a dependent clause from an independent clause.

Writing

Your child will be:

- Creating complex and compound sentences that incorporate conjunctions to elaborate on their written ideas.
- Planning, composing and recording, revising and publishing a Persuasive Writing piece.
- Using persuasive language techniques to convey their point of view.

Speaking and Listening

Your child will be:

- Participating in and contributing to class and group discussions.
- Listening and responding orally to texts.
- Provided with opportunities for oral language presentations.

MATHEMATICS

Your child will be:

- Identifying and describing the properties of prime, composite, square and triangular numbers and using these properties to solve problems and simplify calculations.
- Using mathematical modelling to solve practical problems involving rational numbers and percentages, including in financial contexts.
- Choosing operations and using efficient mental and written calculation strategies, and using digital tools where appropriate; interpreting and communicating solutions in terms of the situation, justifying the choices made.
- Interpreting and comparing data sets for ordinal and nominal categorical, discrete and continuous numerical variables using comparative displays or visualisations and digital tools; comparing distributions in terms of mode, range and shape.
- Measuring, calculating and comparing elapsed time; interpreting and using timetables and itineraries to plan activities and determine the duration of events and journeys.

INQUIRY

Unit: "We Come From The Land Down Under" Learning Area: History Big Question/s:

What significant events and people have influenced the Australia that we know today?

Understandings:

- Before Federation, Australia was broken up into different colonies.
- Significant individuals have played a part in shaping and changing the colony that became Melbourne.
- People migrated to Australia from Europe and Asia for a number of different causes and reasons.
- Colonisation, Federation and Migration have had a significant impact on Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Your child will be:

- Refining and adapting fundamental movement skills particularly striking, catching and throwing in different sports that includes tee ball and softball.
- Creating and adapting the rules of learnt sports/games to promote a more inclusive and fair sport/game.

THE ARTS

Visual Arts

Your child will be:

- Revising the Art elements of; line, shape, space, value, form, texture and colour, through the study of various well-known artists.
- Researching different types of art, eg. abstract, realism, then applying the elements to compose a personal art piece.

Music

Your child will be:

- Working with elements of music and using compositional devices to communicate ideas, perspectives and meaning while composing and playing music.
- Exploring ways that the elements of music are combined to communicate meaning in music across different cultures, times, places and other contexts including from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples.

LOTE - Language Other Than English - Italian

Your child will be:

- Interacting to share interests, leisure activities, feelings and preferences.
- Creating imaginative texts using imaginary characters, places and ideas.

STEM - Digital Technologies

Your child will be:

- Working collaboratively with their peers to create design solutions to STEM challenges and online projects.
- Encouraged to follow online safety protocols (eSafety) when using various online websites and platforms.

Your child will be:

- Describing different ways to express emotions and exploring the relationship between emotions and behaviour
- Identifying some causes of stress and strategies that can be used to reduce stress.
